Invitation:	Each Member Association of Badminton Europe is invited to nominate up to 6 players and 4 coaches to the Badminton Europe Summer School 2011. All training sessions are conducted in English, it is therefore important that all players and coaches can understand and communicate in English.
Age and level of players:	It is recommended that players participating should be in the U17 age group. However the emphasis remains to ensure that there is a high quality of players attending the Summer School. It is therefore acceptable to nominate U19 players. All players should be national level players. All players must be at least 15 years old. <i>The date used to determine a player's age is 31 December 2011.</i>
Dates:	Saturday 16 – Saturday 23 July 2011 Participants are asked to arrive before 16.00 hrs on Saturday 16 July and depart after breakfast on Saturday 23 July 2011.

Staff coaches:	Skilled and experienced staff will be working with participant coaches and players at the Summer School.
Coaches Course:	The Badminton Europe Coach Education material will be presented to coaches at the Summer School.

School fee:	<p>€ 450 per participant</p> <p>Full board and lodging is included. This amount will be invoiced by Badminton Europe.</p> <p>The full amount € 450 must be paid to Badminton Europe in advance. Bank charges have to be paid by the National Associations and will not be accepted by Badminton Europe.</p>
